## MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS

#### TIERRA HOA

# PARK BENCHES, PORCH SWINGS AND OUTDOORS OR LAWN FURNITURE

The minimum acceptable operating standards for the placement of park benches, porch swings and outdoor lawn furniture are as follows:

## 1. PARK BENCHES:

- a. Must be well maintained.
- b. Must be in harmony with the exterior design and color of the house and with the subdivision and must be approved by the Architectural Control Committee.
- c. Black, brown, forest green, white and bronze are acceptable colors as well as a color nearest to the darkest color of the exterior of the home, brick variation included.

### 2. PORCH SWINGS:

- a. Must be well maintained.
- b. Must be in harmony with the exterior design and color of the house.
- c. Must be located on front porch, not front yard.

# 3. <u>OUTDOORS FURNITURE</u>:

- a. Must be well maintained.
- b. Must be in harmony with the exterior design and color of house.
- c. Must not be located in the front yard of any lot and must not be located in the visible side yard on any corner lot.
- d. No plastic furniture of any kind shall be allowed in public view.

## 4. TREE SWINGS:

a. Can only be located in the back yard.
