# COVERED DECKS

The minimum acceptable construction standards for covered decks are as follows:

# **LOCATION:**

- 1. Located in back yard only. Must not encroach on any easement or building line.
- 2. Must be a minimum of sixteen feet (16') from the property line adjacent to public areas, common open space, etc. Must be a minimum of five feet (5') from common side property line and eight feet (8') from a common rear property line.

#### SIZE:

1. Maximum height of cover shall be nine feet (9') above natural ground.

# **MATERIALS:**

- 1. Materials used must be unpainted treated wood, cedar, redwood, or treated wood painted to be in harmony with the existing home. Creosoted wood is not acceptable.
- 2. No corrugated plastic, aluminum or metal roofs are allowed.

Covered deck must be landscaped if not screened from view by a fenced yard.

No flags or weathervanes to be erected on top of roof.

No high intensity spot lights/vapor lights can be attached to the structure.

Deck must be maintained in good condition.

All covered decks must be approved prior to installation by the Architectural Control Committee.
