# MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS

## TIERRA HOA

### **OUTBUILDINGS**

An outbuilding is defined as any attached or detached addition to the lot used for storage, greenhouse, bathhouse, etc. The minimum acceptable construction standards for outbuildings are as follows:

#### LOCATION:

- 1. Outbuildings are not allowed on non-fenced lots.
- 2. Outbuildings are not allowed on lots with wrought iron fencing.
- 3. Outbuildings must be located in rear yard only.
- 4. Outbuildings affixed to the ground must not encroach on any easement or building line.
- 5. Outbuildings must be a minimum of five feet (5') from rear and side property lines.

#### SIZE:

1. Cannot be visible from the public street or any common or open area.

# **MATERIALS:**

- 1. Materials used should match those of the house in both size and color.
- 2. Roof shall be peaked. Roof shall be composition shingles, and closely match the color of shingles on existing home.
- 3. Colors shall be muted, i.e., gray, brown, tan or off white. Can only be located in the backyard.
- 4. The Architectural Control Committee may approve prefabricated storage buildings provided the color blends with the house.
