MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS

TIERRA HOA

PLANTERS, CLAY POTS, BARRELS, ETC.

The minimum acceptable standards for planters, clay pots, barrels, etc. are as follows:

- 1. Planters, clay pots, barrels, etc. are allowed in TIERRA HOA, provided the plants are well maintained and thriving. If the planters do not contain flowers, they must be removed.
- 2. Planters, clay pots, barrels, etc. must be well maintained.
- 3. Location of planters, clay pots, barrels, etc. to be determined by the Architectural Control Committee.
- 4. If planters, clay pots, barrels, etc. are painted, the color must be in harmony with the color of the house.
- 5. Not more than two planters, clay pots, barrels, etc. shall be allowed in public view.
