SECURITY LIGHTS

The minimum acceptable construction standards for installation of security lights are as follows:

- 1. Flood lights are acceptable up to the equivalent of a 100-watt bulb or 1750 lumens.
- 2. No light may be mounted on front of house or front half of either side of house. Positioning of light fixture may not illuminate street or adjacent lots.
- 3. All front yard lights or Entex gas features must be black.
- 4. All lights must be approved by the Architectural Control Committee prior to installation.
- 5. Under no conditions shall light be a nuisance to adjoining residents.
