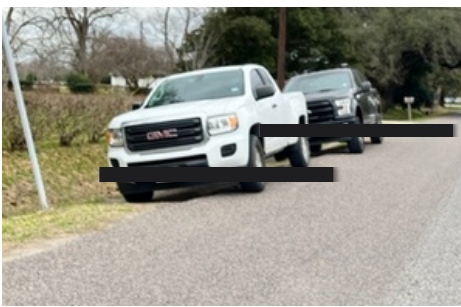

DO YOUR PART TO CREATE SAFE STREETS

No motorized and non-motorized vehicles should be parked or stored on any part of any lot or easement to obstruct a right-of-way. Emergency vehicles and city service vehicles must have unobstructed access to our neighborhood. See Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions Section 12 of the HOA guidelines book

Registering your pet is the law. The City of Houston Municipal Code requires that anyone who owns, keeps, possesses, or has control of a dog or cat four months of age or older must have his or her pet registered, vaccinated against rabies every year, and a registered microchip.



SCHEDULE OF FINES

Written notice of non-compliance will be sent to the owner with a description of each violation and the date of the occurrence. As permitted under the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions for Tierra HOA, the association has the right to set rules and regulations and impose fines, if necessary, to achieve compliance. Fines may be levied and may continue until the violation is corrected.
